He is a Lebanese journalist and politician, who served in various capacities in different cabinets, including Minister of Education, Minister of Telecommunications, Minister of Economy and Trade, Minister of Tourism, Minister of Health and minister for the displaced. He served as a Member of the Lebanese parliament until his resignation, on 5th August 2020, after the 2020 Beirut explosions, due to the government being ineffective.

Mr. Hamadeh holds a law degree, which he earned from Saint Joseph

University in 1963. He received a PhD in economy from the same university.
