Mr. Frem resigned in protest of the corruption and the unproductivity of the Lebanese political system that lead to the financial collapse and Beirut Explosion in 2020.

On May 2018, he was elected to represent Keserwan-Jbeil constituency. He served as Chair of National Economy, Trade, and Industry & Planning Parliamentary Commission.

He is the Chairman and Chief Executive of the multinational company INDEVCO Group employing over 10,000 people worldwide.



He is the Founder and President of Phoenix Machinery and former President of the Association of Lebanese Industrialists.

He presided on The Maronite Foundation in the world from 2016 to 2018 and is currently the honorary president of the said foundation.

In July 2018, Mr. Frem received a Doctorate Honoris Causa from Holy Spirit University of Kaslik. Mr. Frem is the founder & Board Member of many associations promoting interreligious (Christian-Islam) dialogue.
