Mr. Samy Gemayel is a resigned member of Lebanese Parliament and currently serving as the 7th President of the Lebanese Kataeb Party.

Since his election in 2015, he has introduced a new approach to political party practice, one building on a deliberative decision-making process across all party levels. Further, Mr. Gemayel opened the doors of the Kataeb to partnerships with civil society organizations on major political, economic and developmental issues.

Mr. Gemayel was elected to Parliament in June of 2009 and re-elected for a second mandate in May 2018 representing the North Metn constituency. He is member of three Parliamentary committees: Defense, Security and local governance; Human Rights; Education and Culture.

In his legislative capacity, Mr. Gemayel has been recognized as one of the most active parliamentarians of his term owing to the number of proposals and bills he passed.

Mr. Gemayel holds a B.A. in Law (2003) and an M.A. in Public Law (2005) from the Université Saint-Joseph in Beirut.
