PROFILE

Dr. Fouad Abou Nader was the Head of the Lebanese Forces 1984-85 and a member of Political Bureau-Kataeb Party 1986-1992. Most recently, he served as the President Liberty Front from 2007 till 2014.

Alongside Abou Nader's political career, he is an active member in notable professional bodies and non-governmental organizations. Previously, he was the founder of multiple NGOs including Arc-En-Ciel Rehabilitation of the Handicapped in 1984, Jeunesse Promesse Social and Medical Services in 1985, and Eastern Christian Assembly which represents all 14 Churches in the M.E since 2010. He was also a member of the Lebanese Order of Physicians in 1982. Today, Fouad is the President of the Nawraj NGO, for Economical and Social Development since 2014.

Professionally, Fouad is the Chairman of Tanit Group which includes Tanit Paramedic SAL Lebanon and Tanit Medical Engineering LTD- Nigeria.

A Baskinta native, Dr. Abou Nader attended the American University of Beirut as a pre-med undergrad and received his medical degree from Saint Joseph Faculty of Medicine in 1982
