Mr. Abousleiman served as Minister of Labor for Lebanon in 2019 and resigned in Oct 2020, but continued in a caretaker capacity until Jan 2021. He is currently Of Counsel at Dechert, a leading global law firm. Previously, he was the Chairman of Dechert's London Office, a member of the firm's Management Committee, and the Global Head of the Emerging Markets and International Capital Markets's Departments. He advised on some of the most innovative and complex emerging market transactions and is recognized as a leading authority in emerging markets. He represents several countries in their issuance of debt on the international markets. He was named one of the Top 10 Financial Lawyers in Europe by the Financial Times, and award by The International Financial Law Review, Mr. Abousleiman is one of the founders of Lebanese International Finance Executives (LIFE), and, through the Chaker Abousleiman Foundation, maintains a number of scholarships for deserving Lebanese students at Saint Joseph University, Harvard University, and others. Camille is a member of the New York State Bar and the Beirut Bar and earned his law degrees from Saint Joseph and Harvard Universities.
