

PROFILE

Choucri Sader has a 44 year career in the Lebanese judiciary in fields of commercial, civil, and criminal law. He was appointed as President of the Council of Legislation and Legal Advices at the Ministry of Justice in Lebanon. He was also a member of the Lebanese delegation tasked with establishment of the United Nations Tribunal for Feb 14 assassination. He was granted Legion of Honor, Officer Grade, by France, notably for his efforts to consolidate legal ties between Lebanon, France, and Europe, and for his continuous support for the Francophone. Sader has multiple publications and was a guest speaker at reputable conferences some of which were hosted by World Bank and Beirut Bar Association. Sader earned a French Law degree from University of Lyon, a Lebanese Law degree from Saint Joseph University, in addition to Masters in Public Law and MA in Comparative Law from the same university.
