Gemayel was a member of the Lebanese Parliament since 2009 representing Beirut District and Chairman of the Information and Technology Parliamentary Committee since June 2018 until his resignation after the Beirut Port blast on August 4, 2020. He currently holds several positions focused on public interest and public service in Lebanon. Nadim Gemayel's main objective is to preserve the Christian's presence and identity in Lebanon and the region through reinforcing their involvement in the National equilibrium of powers and their role in building a peaceful, stable and sustainable State based on Freedom, Justice and Security for all its components. Nadim believes in a sovereign and free Lebanon for all Lebanese respecting the international resolution notably the 1559 UNSC calling upon Lebanon to establish its sovereignty over all of its land and disbanding of all militias on the Lebanese soil. Nadim is also founder of Achrafieh 2020, focused on creating accessible and environment-friendly public areas, and shaping new behaviors considering the challenges of the City. He holds Masters in Lebanese Law from the Lebanese University and a Masters in Public Law from Assas University. Gemayel currently holds multiple positions:

- Member of the Lebanese Social Democratic (Kataeb) party | 2005 - Present
- CEO of the Bachir Gemayel Foundation | 2001 Present
