Jean produces blogs, position papers, press statements, information materials, and policy studies related to US-Arab political, economic, and security issues. He has been involved in US-Arab advocacy for more than 40 years, having been the first Arab American to lobby on US policies in the MENA region. He recently produced several articles analyzing scenarios for the Biden Administration on US relations with the Arab world. He has been traveling to the MENA for more than 40 years and served as the President/CEO of the National US-Arab Chamber of Commerce, and Executive Director of the Moroccan American Trade and Investment Center. He is currently Vice-President for Policy at the American Task Force on Lebanon. He also consults on strategic communications and organizational change for both international and US clients; has led a graduate level seminar at Georgetown University; lectured at American University on international development and challenges in intercultural negotiations; presents to senior foreign officials and embassy staff at the National Defense University; and a leads a seminar on effective negotiations at Al-Akhawayn University in Morocco.
