PROFILE

Yassine Yassine was born in 1971, Ghazze West Bekaa. He obtained his high school diploma from Ghazze Public School. In 1988 he immigrated to the United States. He completed his education at the University of Toledo majoring in Biology. He founded his own telecommunications company, Page Plus Cellular. This company rapidly grew all over the states. In 2015, Yassine returned to Lebanon where he established the Nafila Charity Association, which provides health services by purchasing the Hariri Medical Center and provides educational services by purchasing Almaqasid Islamic Charitable School, which includes more than 750 students. In 2016 began focusing on what matters to the area in both the healthcare and food industries Taanayel General Hospital was purchased to provide healthcare to all Bekaa residents. Also in that year National Produce and Packaging company was purchased, a facility that caters to the farmers of fruits and vegetables and also to supermarkets locally and regionally by exporting and importing fruits and vegetables from and to the Arab World. In 2017 Mr Yassine established Homescape; a home building material store that sells all home building materials industrial and lifestyle products; a facility that occupies more than 500,000 sf and includes two factories (Marble and wood factories). The above companies were purchased or established within two years and now employs a little less than 1,000 employees.
