Political Involvement:

Social Development:

- Designation of a building of 55 rooms in Koura for COVID-19 patients quarantine with the coordination of the Ministry of Health and the Union of Koura Municipalities.
- Donation of three speedboats to the Lebanese Internal Security Forces for the transport of soldiers and immediate emergency intervention against terrorist acts.
- Donation of two ambulances for the Red Cross Center in Koura and the renovation and the equipment of the hotline operating room in the North (work in progress).
- Financial aid programs to needy families in Koura.
- School and university scholarships for students.
- Hospitalization and medical support for patients in need.
- Supporting with utility bills in the local communities of Koura region.
- Support of several urban and agricultural projects affected by the devastating economic situation.
- Installation of many solar panels and electrical systems to support the water wells for farmers and villages.

Massih is the Chairman and CEO of Marine Core Group, established in Dubai and is in charge of harbors construction.
