# **Lebanon and the Game of Nations**

#### **PROFILE**

#### **Kataeb Party:**

- · 1973-1975: Appointed as Vice President to the department responsible for all Kataeb party members in Lebanon (+100k members).
- · 1975: Established the first Bachir Gemayel/Kataeb party office in Sao Paolo, Brazil, and mobilized the Lebanese diaspora, incentivizing their involvement in the local politics and contributing to increasing the share of representatives of Lebanese origins in the Brazilian government from ~2% to ~20%.
- 1977: Planned Bachir Gemayel's trip to the USA, strategically setting up meetings with key US stakeholders in 8 states, including the US State Department, Pentagon, Intelligent Community (e.g. FBI, CIA), US Congress and media, laying the ground to establish the Bachir Gemayel/Kataeb office in the US.
   1978–1984: Established and headed the Bachir Gemayel/Kataeb office in the US and lobbied for and influenced US policies in favor Lebanon and Bachir Gemayel, ultimately contributing to the US supporting Bachir Gemayel to become President of Lebanon.
- · 1986-1994: Oversaw all Kataeb and Lebanese Forces activities in Beirut as President of Ashrafiyeh sector, assuming all government responsibilities, including water, food and fuel distribution, elderly care, scholarships and key events planning.
