She handled a wide range of broadcast duties including general field reporting, developing story ideas, interviewing community, civic, educational, business and political leaders. Denise covered as a senior reporter national, regional and international conferences, and many Arabic, Islamic and francophone summits. She followed the work of Special Tribunal for Lebanon since it was formed until the ruling was issued. Denise covered for more than 10 years the Lebanese Parliament activities and the Lebanese cabinet meetings since Prime Minister Salim Hoss through Omar Karame, Rafic Hariri, Fouad Siniora, Saad Hariri, Najib Mikati, Salim Hassan Diab. Denise participated at the coverage of Israeli war with Lebanon in 2006, and worked during the period of Syrian occupation of Lebanon. She hosts political figures (deputies, ministers, prime ministers, party leaders) in a weekly talk show at Radio Free Lebanon. Denise is Media consultant with the presidential candidate May Rihani.
